THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, there has been deposited in the General Land Office an Order, approved November 3, 1915, by the Secretary of the Interior, directing that a patent issue to the State of Montana, in accordance with the Act of Congress approved February 11, 1915, (38 Stat., 807), for the following-described land, to-wit: The south half of the southwest quarter of Section twenty-two, the north

half of the northwest quarter, the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter and the west half of the southwest quarter of Section twenty-seven, the south half, the northwest quarter, the east half of the northeast quarter and the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section twenty-eight, the east half of Section twenty-nine, the east half of the northeast quarter of Section thirty-two, section thirty-three and the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section thirty-four in Township thirty-two north of Range fifteen east of the Montana Meridian, Montana, containing one thousand nine hundred sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor-General:

Now know ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the provisions of ^{the} said act of congress, has given and granted, and by these presents does give and grant, unto the said State of Montana, the tracts of land above described; To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said State of Montana, and to its assigns, forever. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

In testimony whereof, I, Woodrow Wilson, President of the United States, of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the Sixth day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and fortieth.
